Course Outline: This course is intended for end users and support staff who need to learn the advanced features of the Query licensed program. The course includes joining files in different ways, output the results of a query to a database file in different ways, create new fields for numeric calculations, date and time conversions, substringing, concatenation etc., transferring files generated by query to your PC etc.

Prerequisites: Delegates wishing to attend this course will ideally have been on the Basic Query course (ISQRY) or have the equivalent hands on experience.
